


Our Location

Ready, steady, learn


When your child arrives at School each day they will find an array of activities planned for them. Perhaps they will choose model-making, water-play, reading or number work?

They can move freely from one activity to the next with our guidance and encouragement. This ensures that they are always interested, independent and actively learning.

We plan each day's activities carefully so your child absorbs new skills and makes rapid progress. Because your child is having fun, they will learn quickly and you will see their confidence grow.

We read stories together every day, and always go out to the park for fresh air and exercise – or maybe a musical bear hunt or a science experiment. Each Nursery visits its local library regularly, to borrow books, investigate and listen to stories.





Active and creative

At Eaton Square Nursery Schools we give your child an amazingly broad range of experiences. They will discover what they love to do and can really shine. They also learn how much fun it is to try new things and attack everyday with enthusiasm and energy.

Your child's physical development is one of the prime areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum, so alongside our regular outdoor activities we offer specialist lessons in swimming, karate, yoga and ballet. We are thrilled to see our children enjoying the water so much at our annual swimming gala – it's a real highlight of our year!







Your child will soon feel comfortable performing and creating and we invite you regularly to see your child making music, performing plays, demonstrating their karate or ballet, competing in sports day, and sharing their artwork.

We bring all of the children in our Nurseries together for our Christmas performance in church, and at the end of the year we gather again for a special graduation ceremony for the children who are moving on to the next stage of their education at Eaton Square. We are a close community of children, families and staff, and it's always a joy to celebrate our achievements together.
