through education.

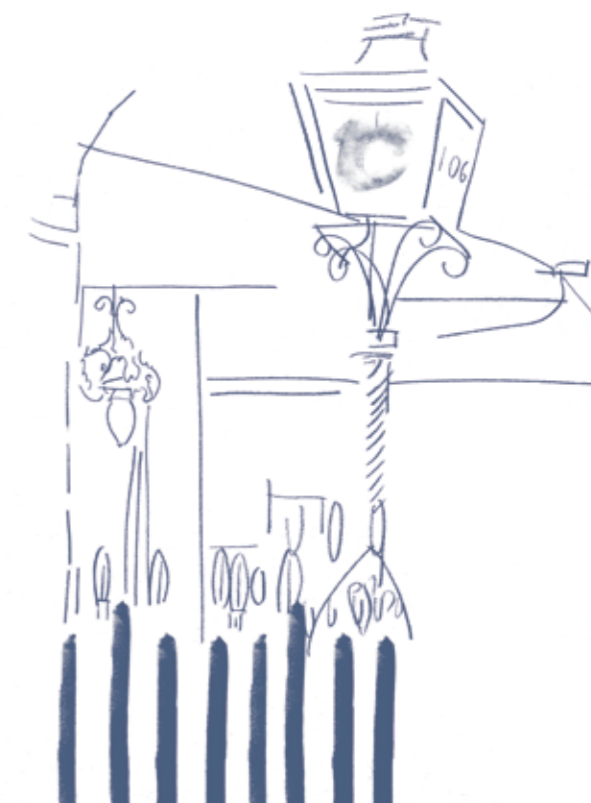

The setting for Eaton Square Mayfair is a stunning Grade 1 listed building that spans five storeys. Dating from 1762, its grand staircases, chandeliers and marble pillars create an awe-inspiring learning environment.

The building blends traditional British architecture with state-of-the-art facilities. In addition to modern classrooms and multiple science labs, the school also features a beautiful art studio and drama room.

Your child might play electric guitar in a room lined with 18th century green silk wallpaper, study history in a room designed by Robert Adam, or do PE in the room where Ian Fleming wrote a Bond novel. This is where learning comes to life.

THE ROYAL PARKS ARE OUR PLAYGROUND



Our school is just down the road from Hyde Park and directly opposite Green Park, a Royal Park that offers over 40 acres of trees and tranquillity. Every day, pupils spend their lunch break in one of the Royal Parks, where they can go for a walk or a run and let off steam.

As it's just across the road, we use the park as a 'green classroom'. Pupils go there for outdoor art classes, take their easels and paint watercolours of the landscape, including native oak trees, silver limes and rare black poplars.

English classes also take advantage of this amazing natural resource for quiet reading time and walks that inspire the pupils creative writing.

'We go to Hyde Park a lot. We usually go there for break times and at lunch – we run around and catch some fresh air. It's nice to have the park right there to visit whenever we want.'

From years 7-9, your child will have weekly drama lessons which will help deepen their knowledge of English literature and build their confidence in public speaking.

Inspiring a love of music
From Years 7–9, all pupils take a general music class that covers composing, performing and analysing music from different genres, exploring a range of repertoire.



Music opens doors for children. It isn't just a universal language; it helps your child develop valuable transferable skills. Analysing music pieces develops listening skills and literacy, while learning about notation and rhythms is beneficial for maths.

Music also gives your child a different way to express themselves and helps them gain confidence through performing. Our pupils have the opportunity to play at concerts, in rock bands and ensembles in the grand surroundings of the Adams Room.
