Head

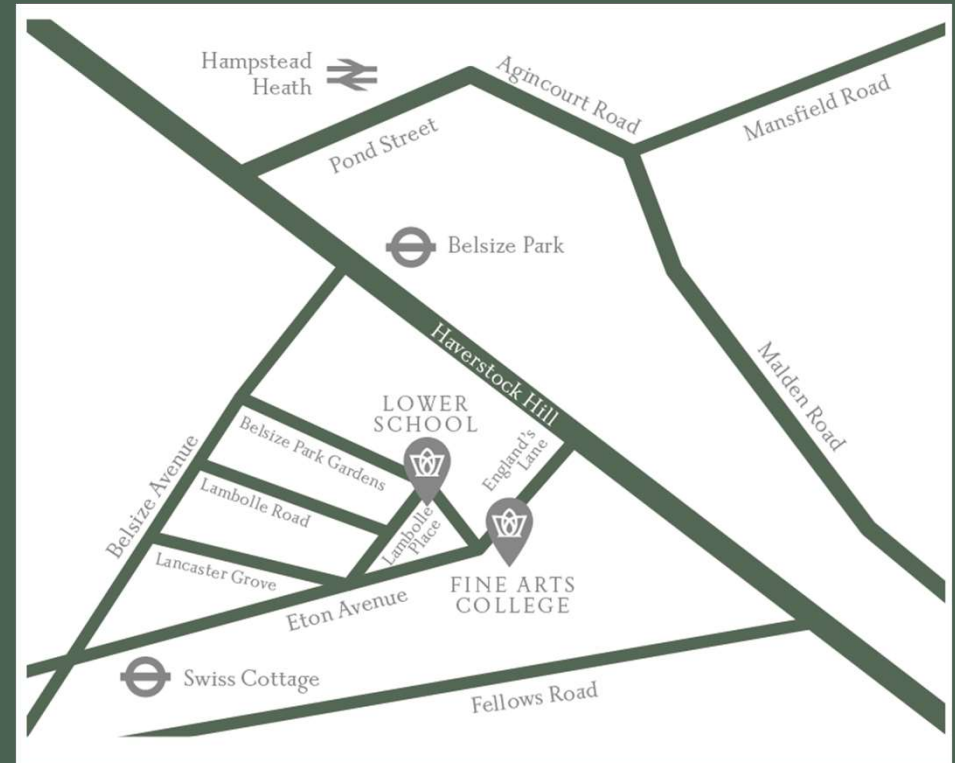
